

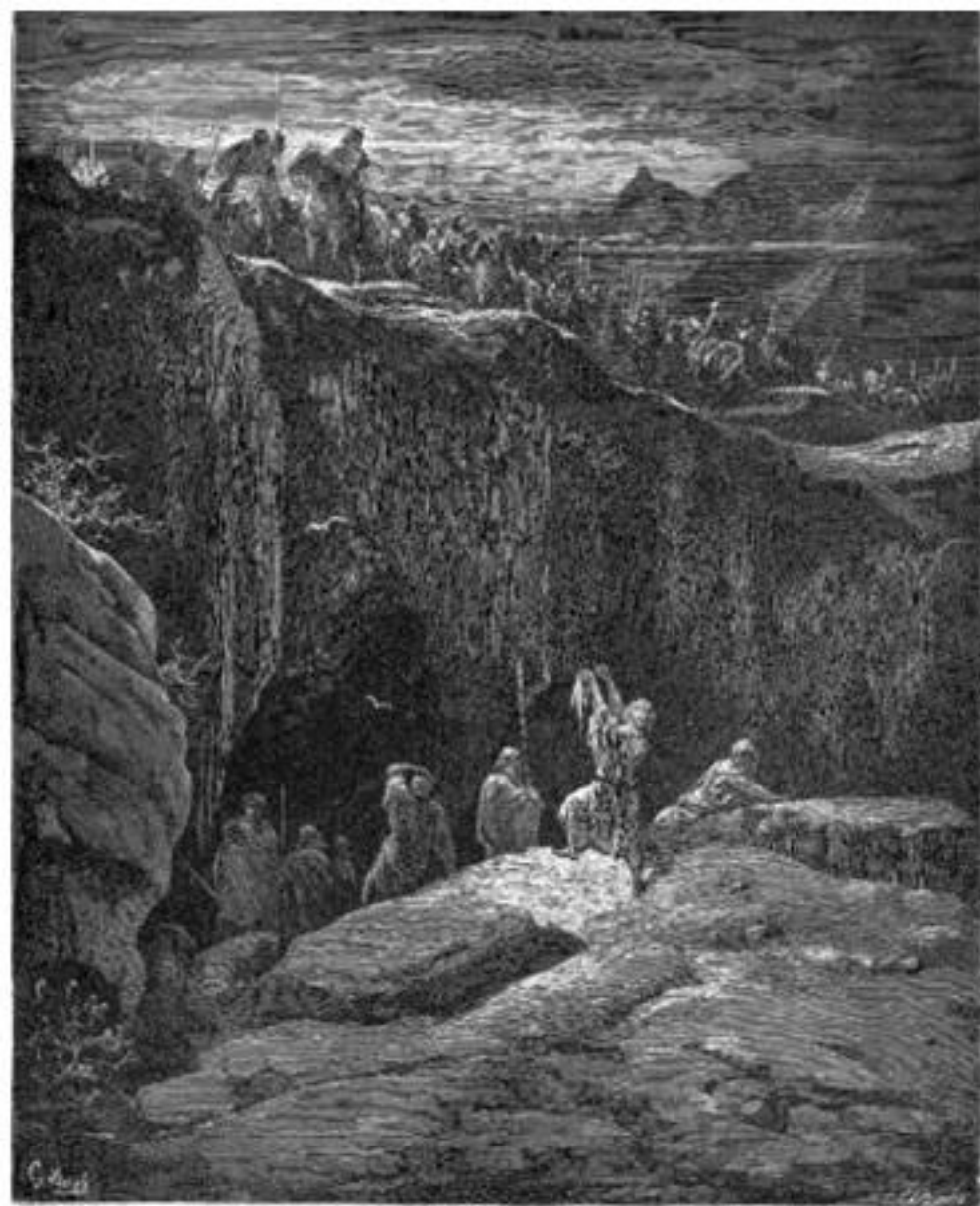

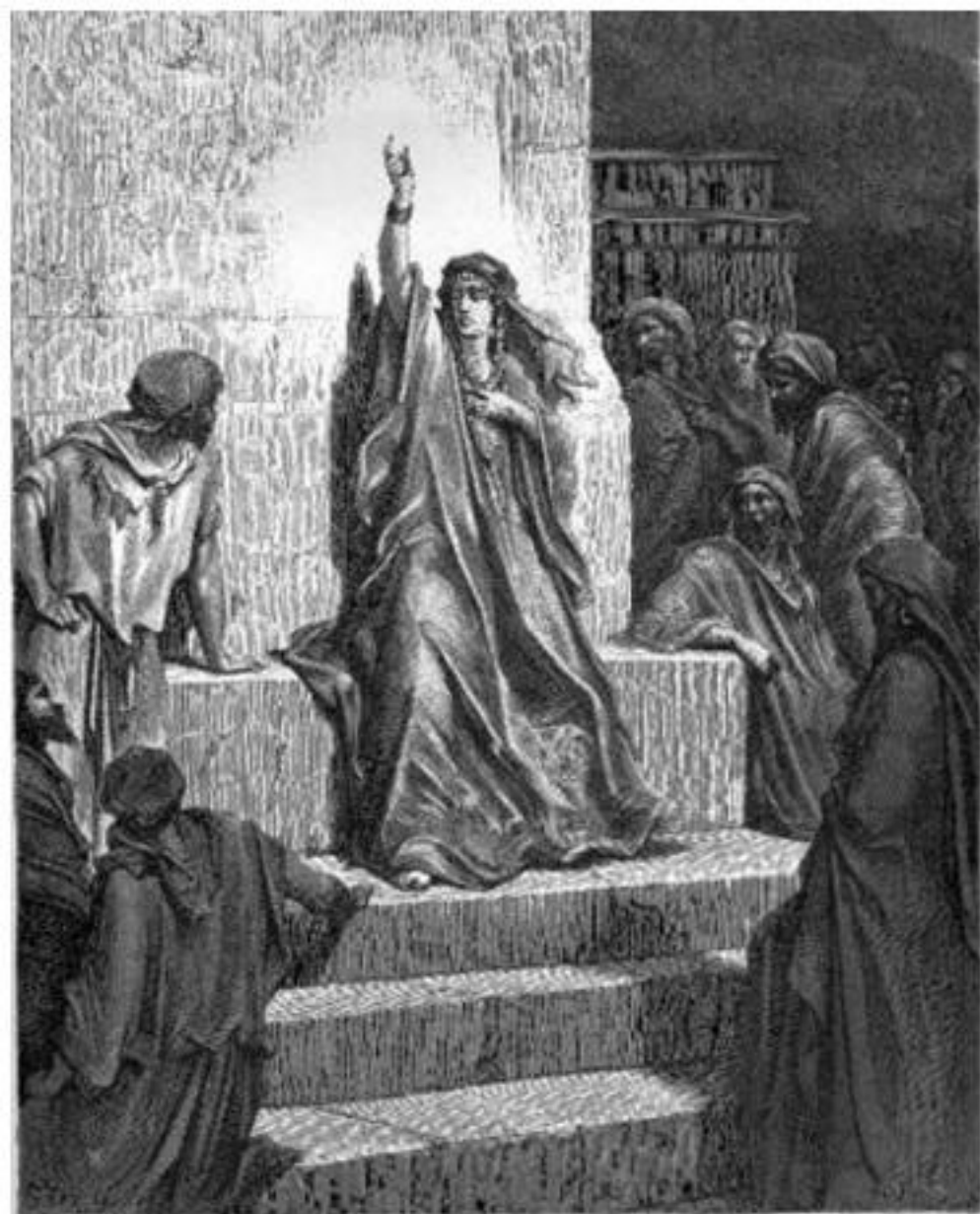
DAVID SHOWING SAUL THAT HE HAD SPARED HIS LIFE

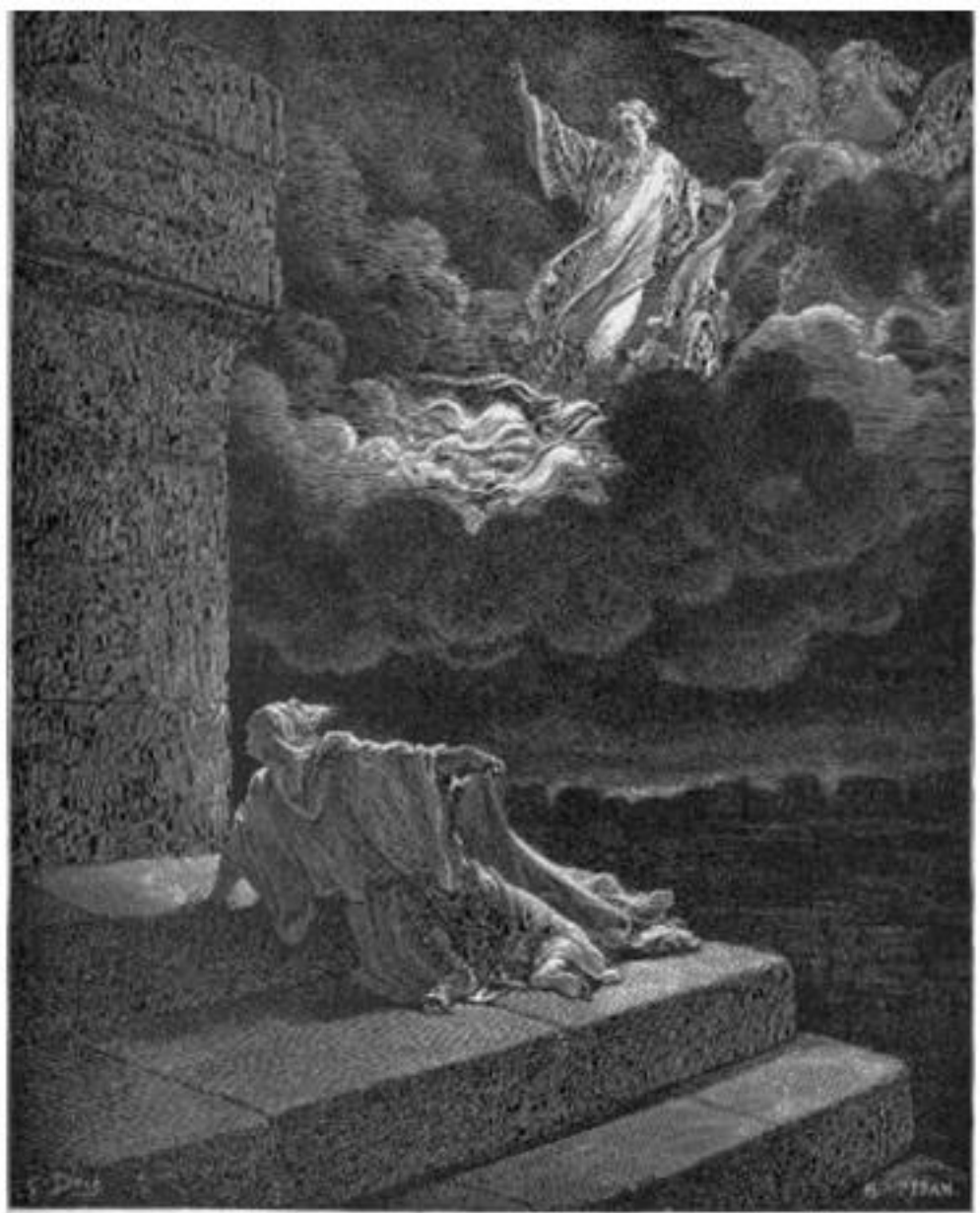
DAVID AND GOLIATH

fell down, it was pain, and fainted . . . (Esther (Apocrypha) 13: 6, 7)



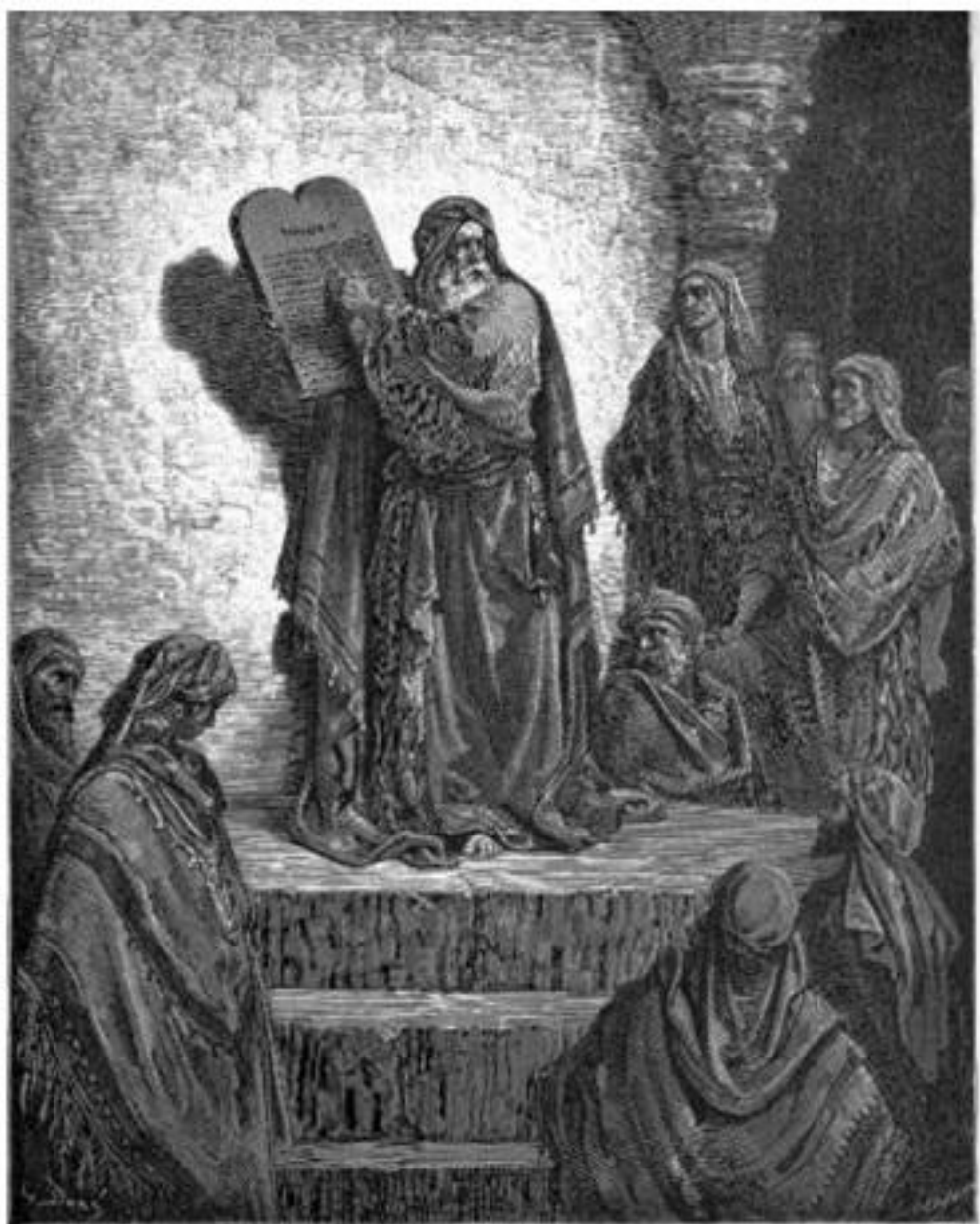
THE VISION OF THE VALLEY OF DRY BONES

(2 Kings 17:26) (17:25)



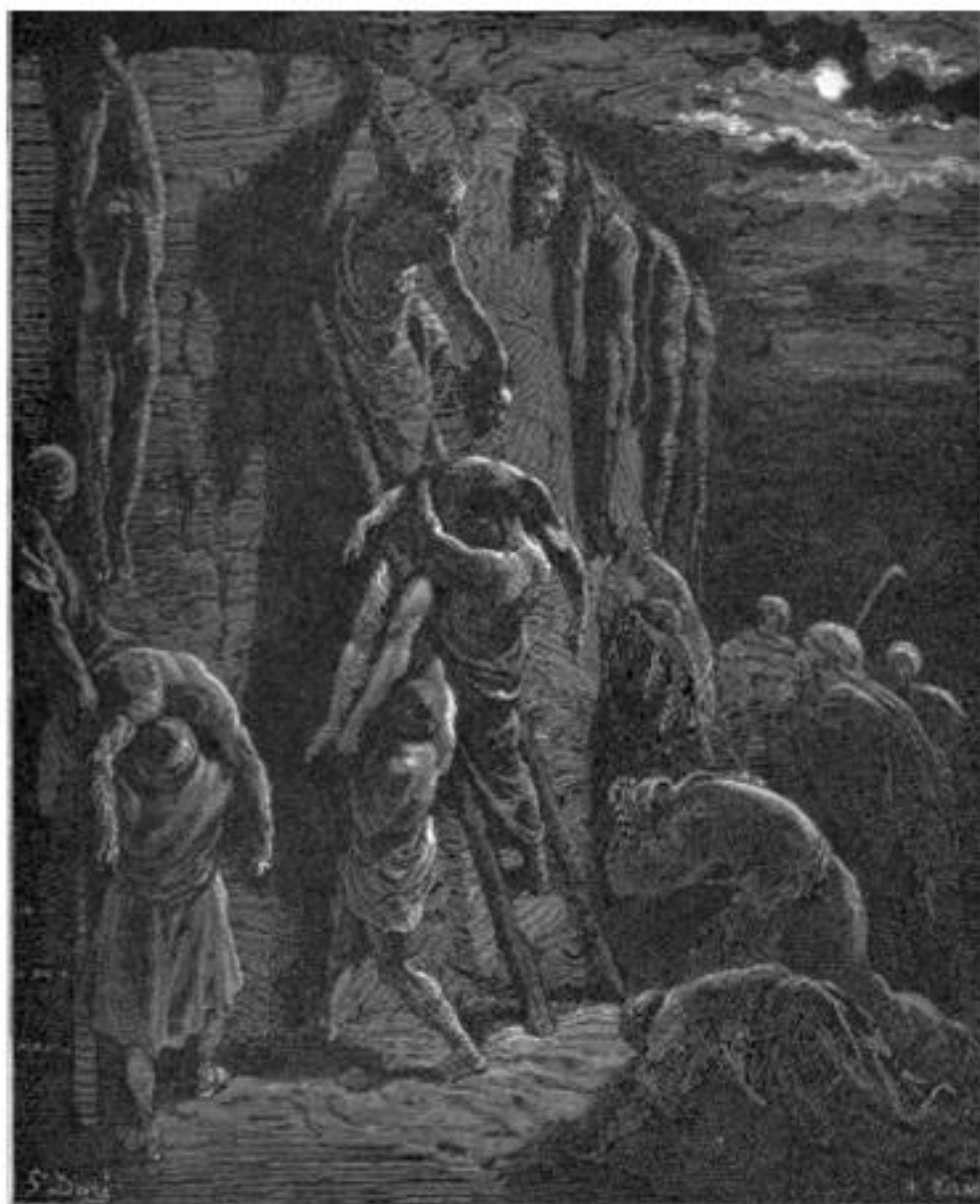
HAGAR AND ISHMAEL IN THE WILDERNESS

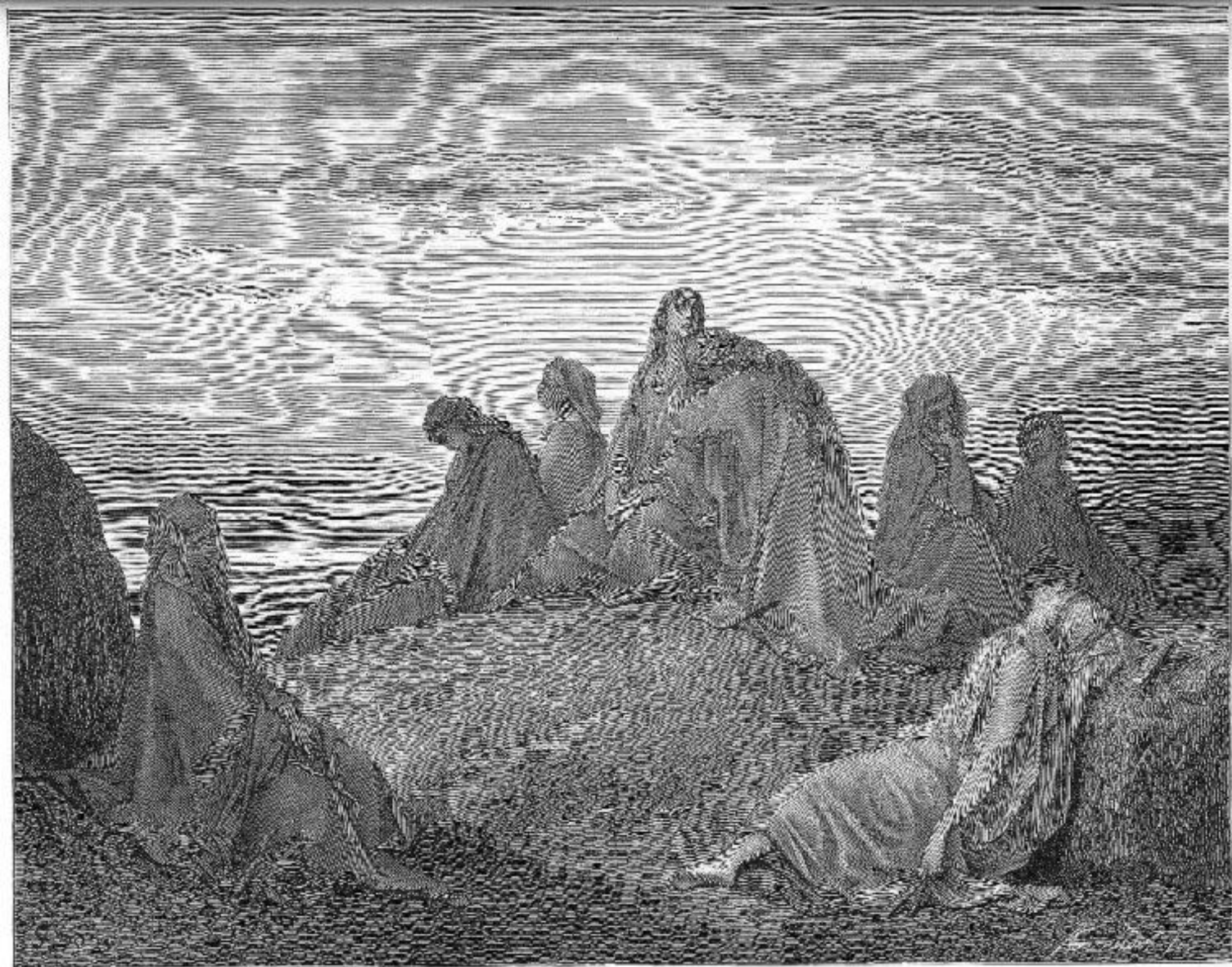
THE CONFUSION OF TONGUES

So the people shouted when the priests blew with the trumpets; and it came to pass, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with

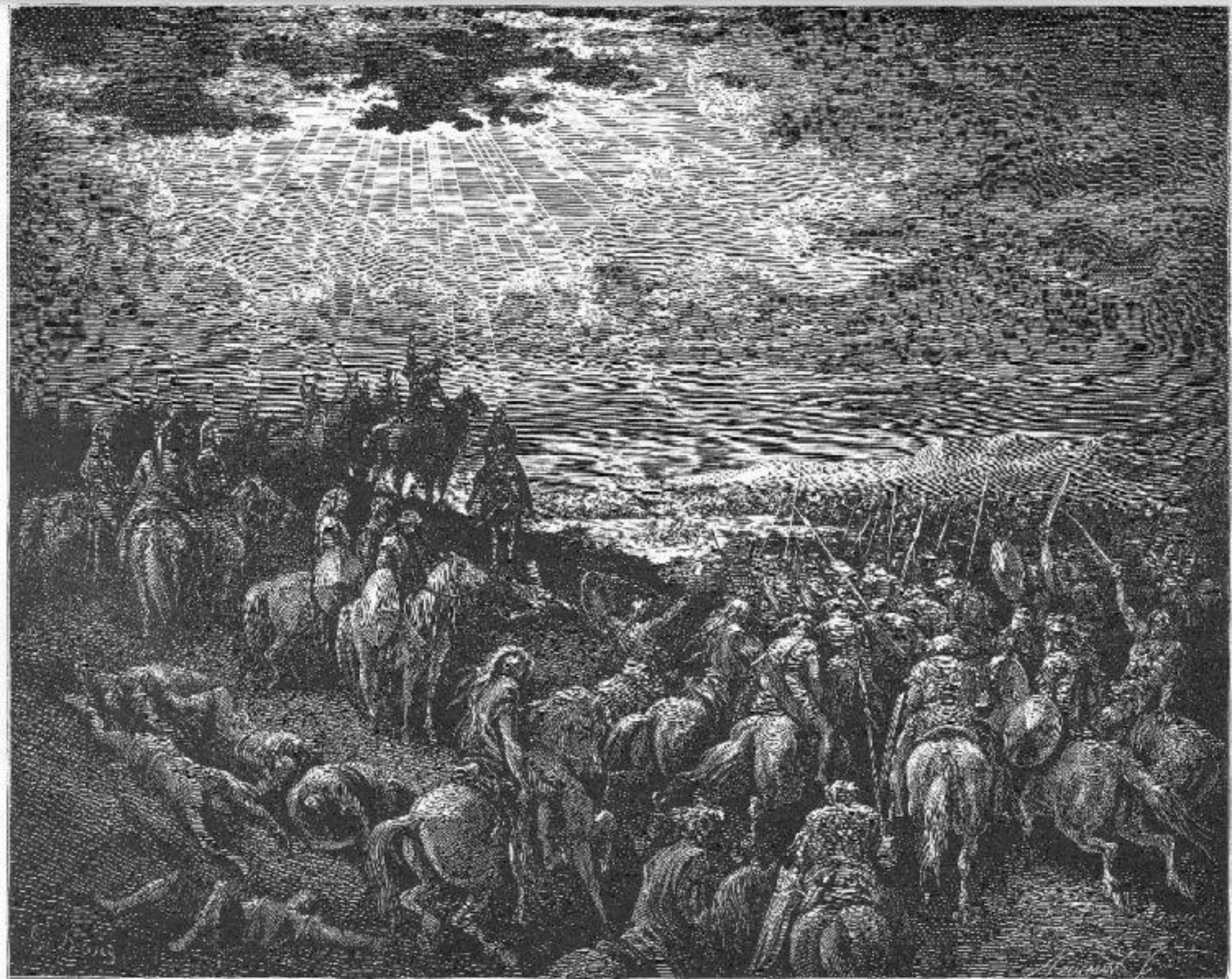


THE DAUGHTERS OF ISRAEL LAMENTING THE DAUGHTER OF JEPHTHAH

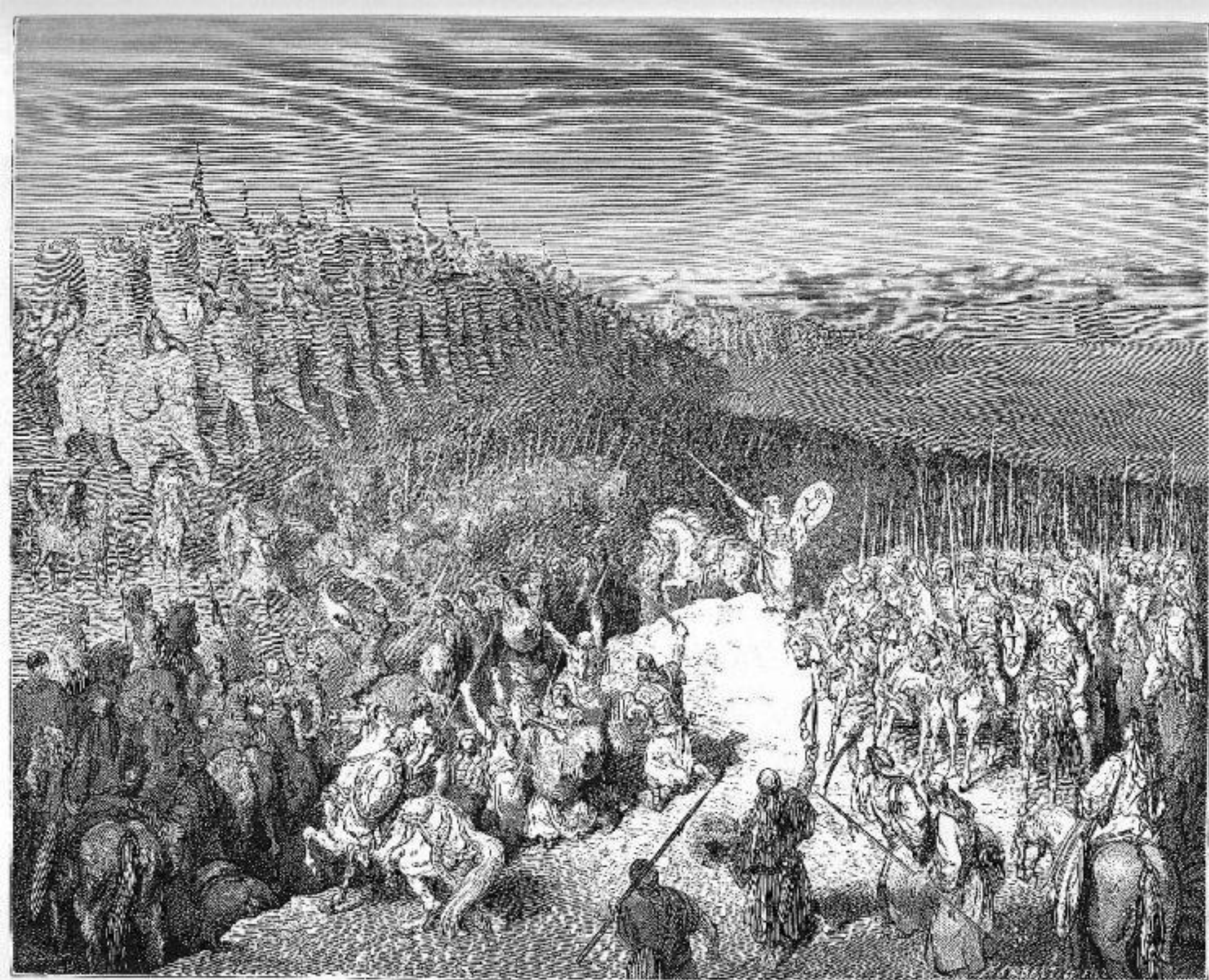
