JONATHAN DESTROYING THE TEMPLE OF DAGON

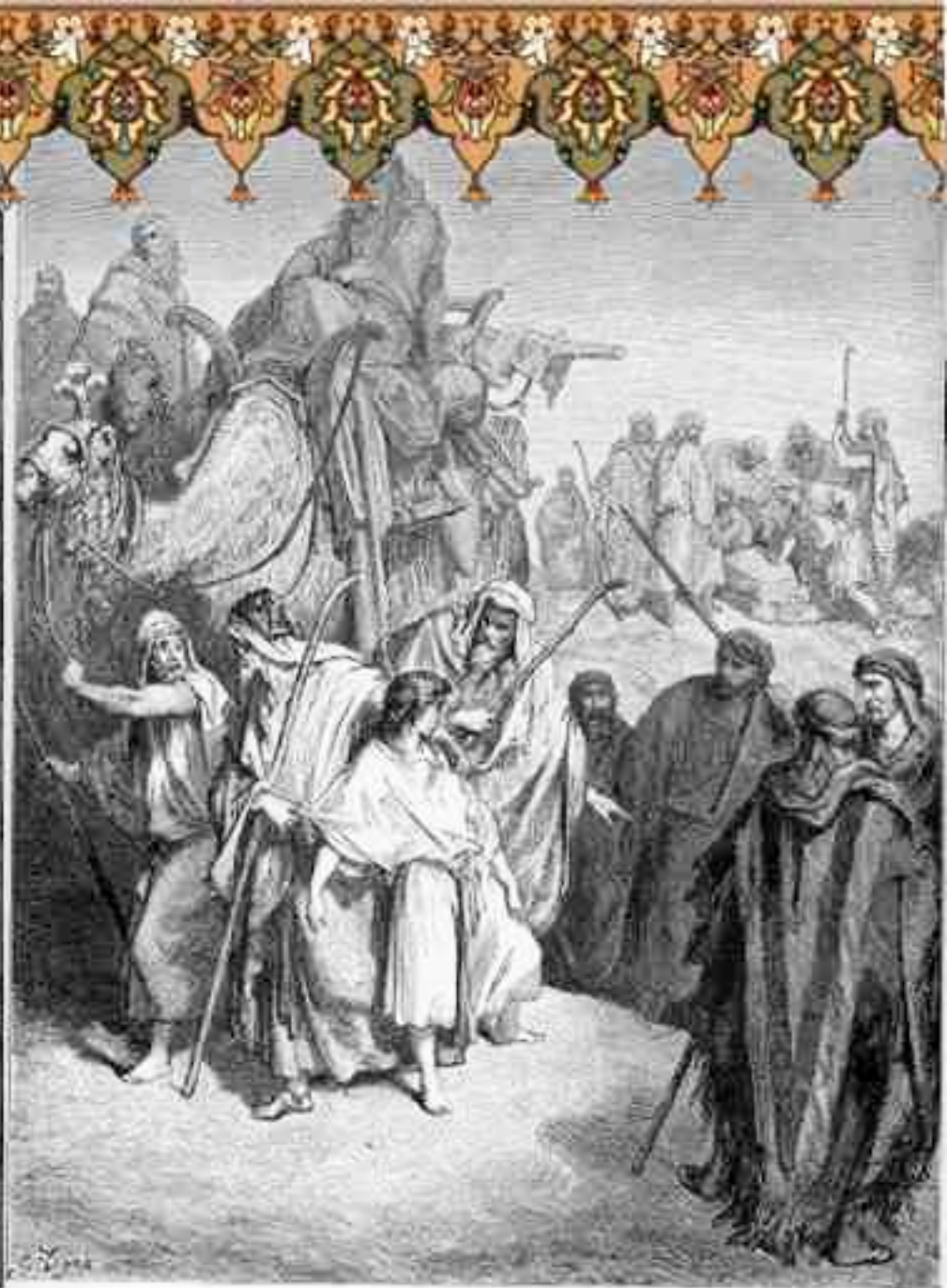

HOPHRA COMMITTING THE TOWN OF AI TO THE FLAMES

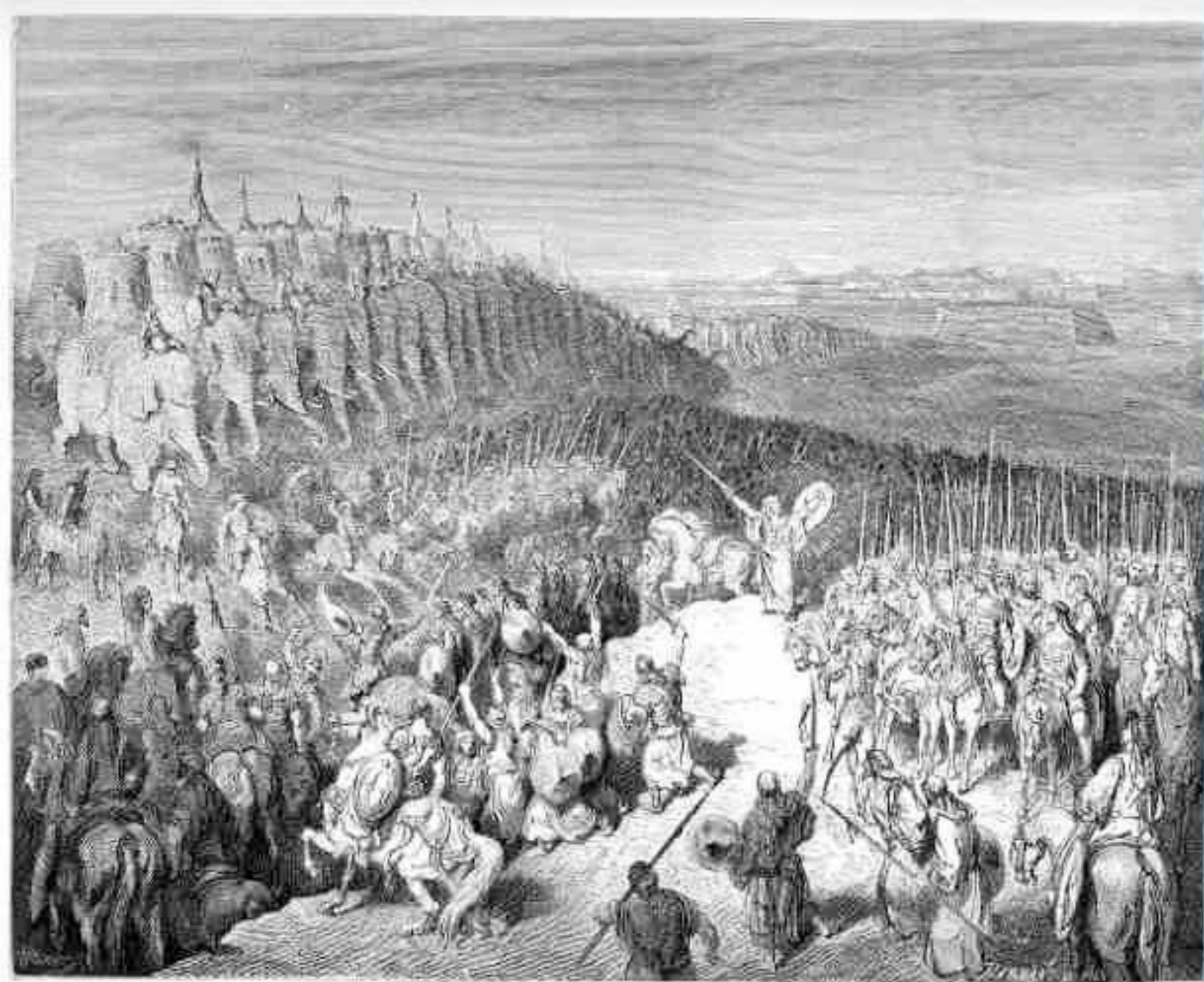
And the Lord said unto Joshua, Stretch out the spear that is in thy hand toward

JUDITH SPARES HATHAS

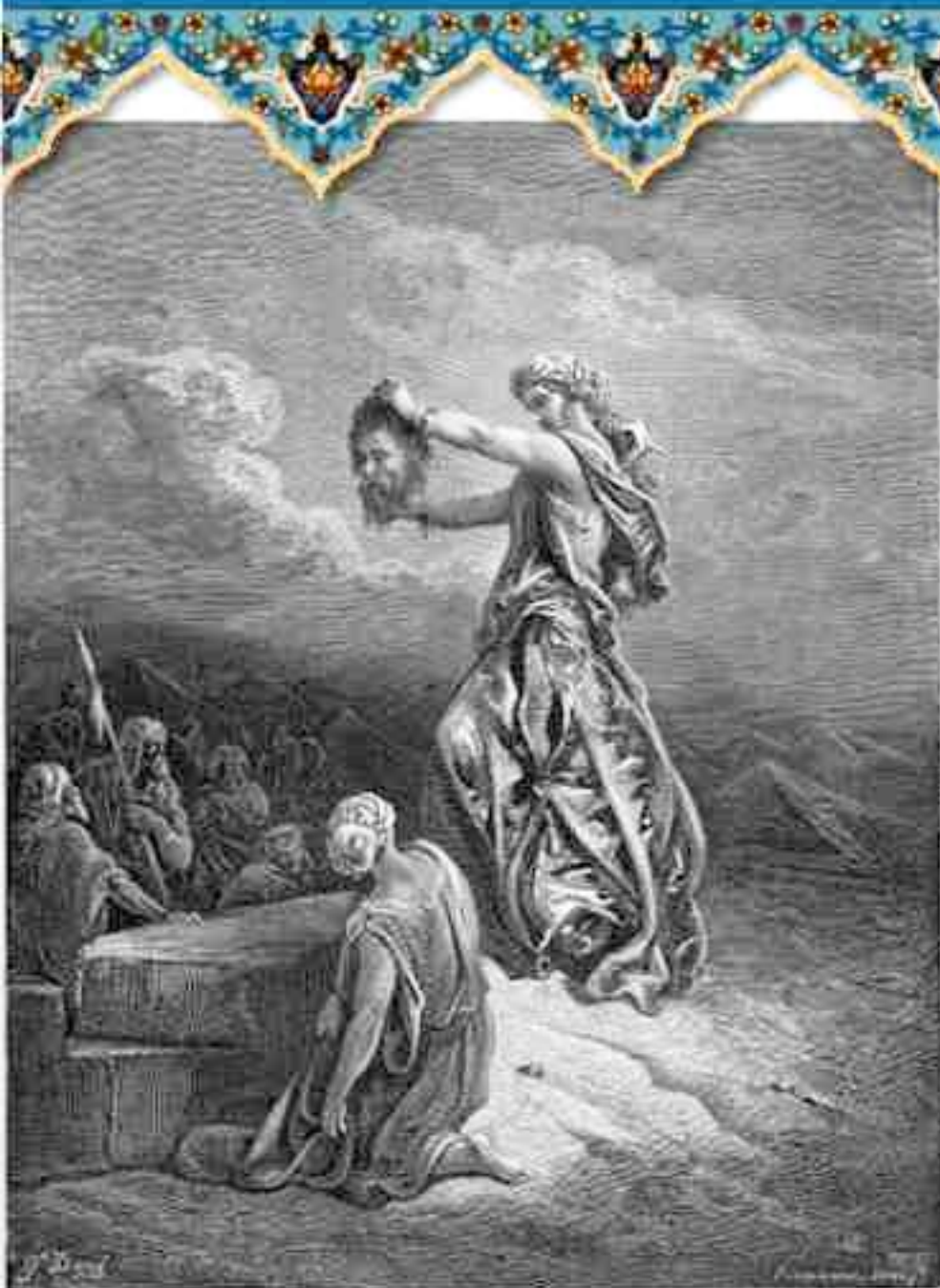
And Judith stood HATHAS the hater alive, and her father's blood shed, because she hid the weapons, which Judith had swept out beneath. — Judith v. 20



DEATH AND HOLOFERNES

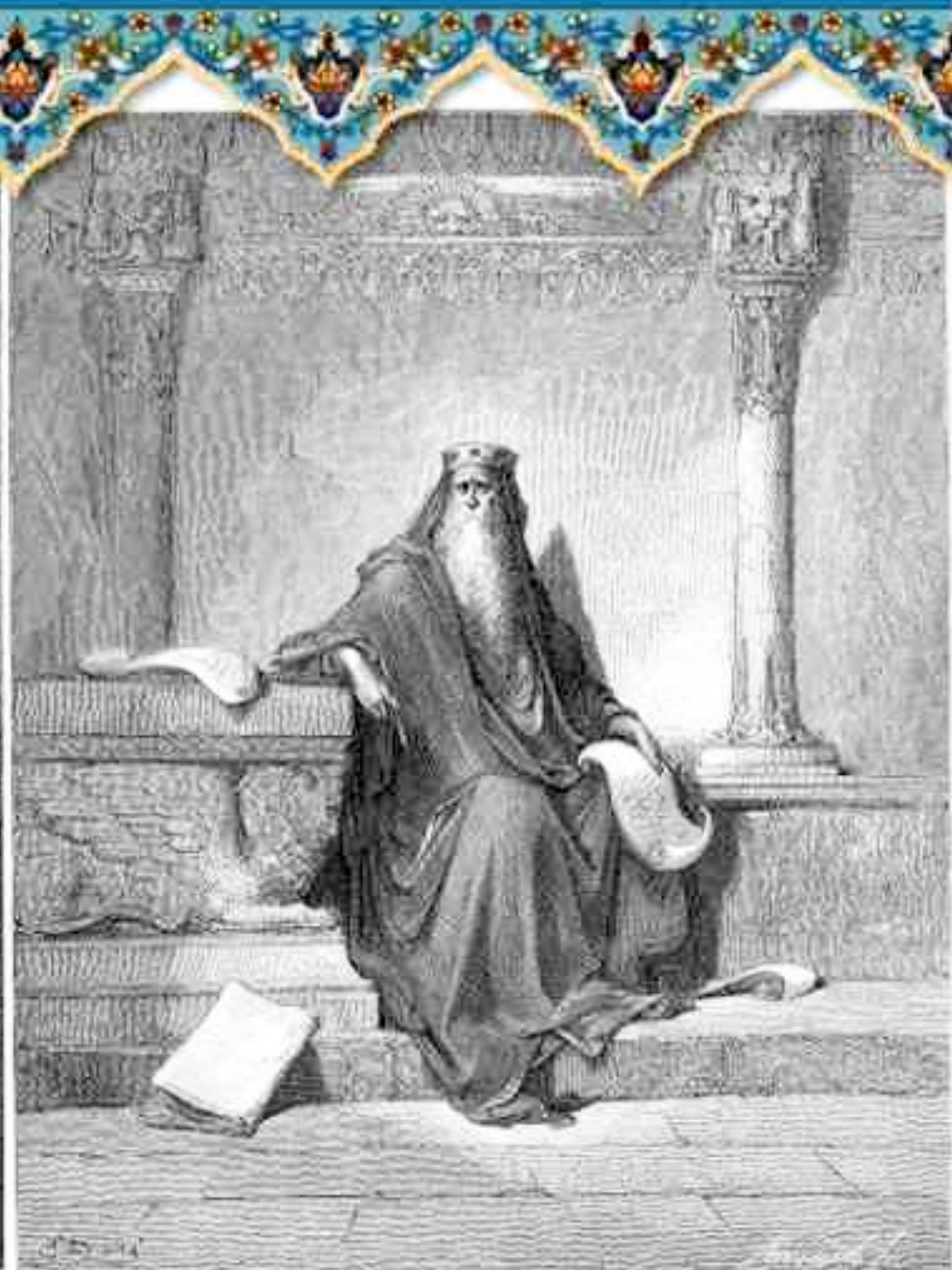
And she smote down upon his neck with all her might, and she took away his head. — Judith x. 21

THE FLIGHT OF LOT

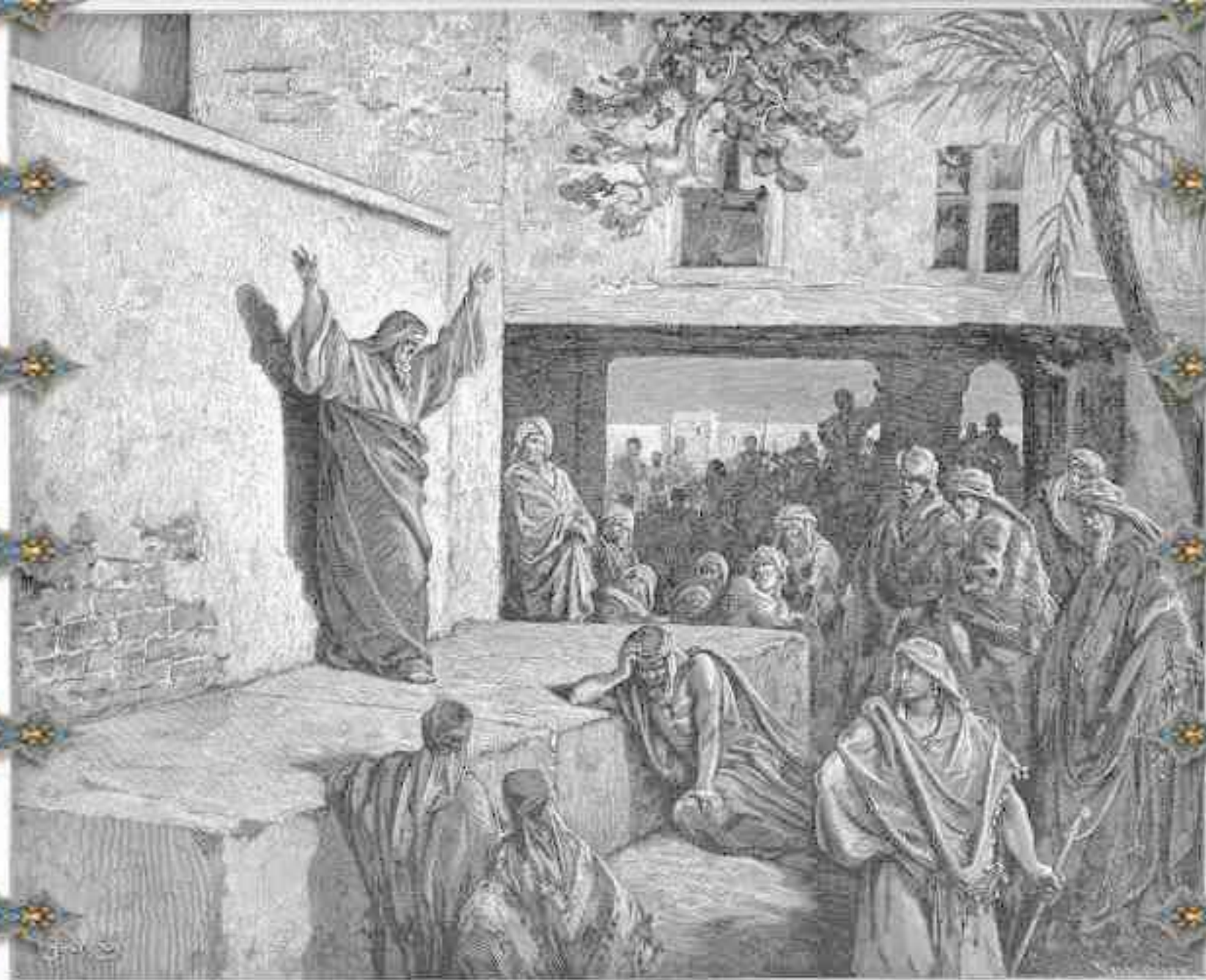
