between his arms, and died with him. — 1 Samuel 31: 4, 5.



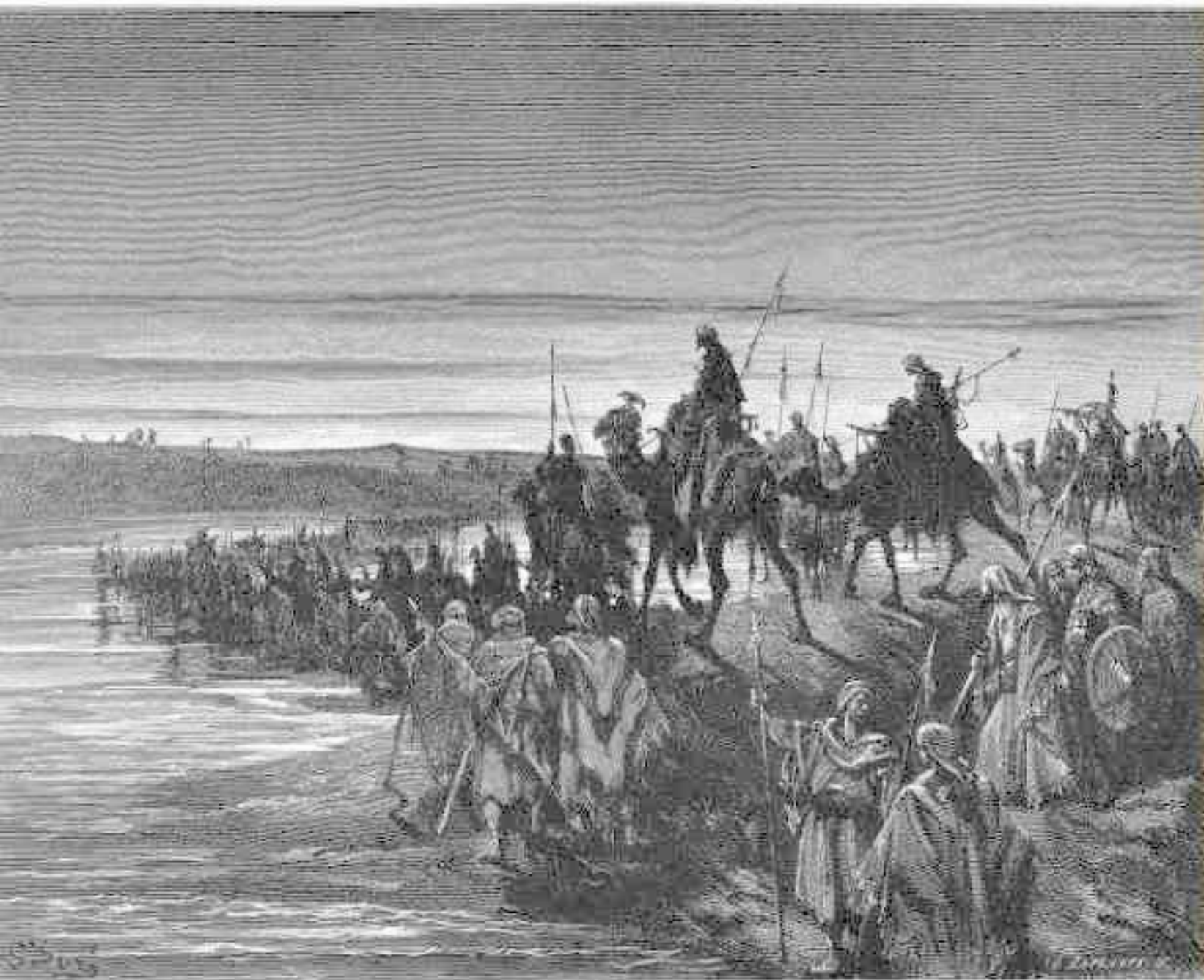
THE EGYPTIANS URGE MOSES TO DEPART

JUDGMENT OF SOLOMON

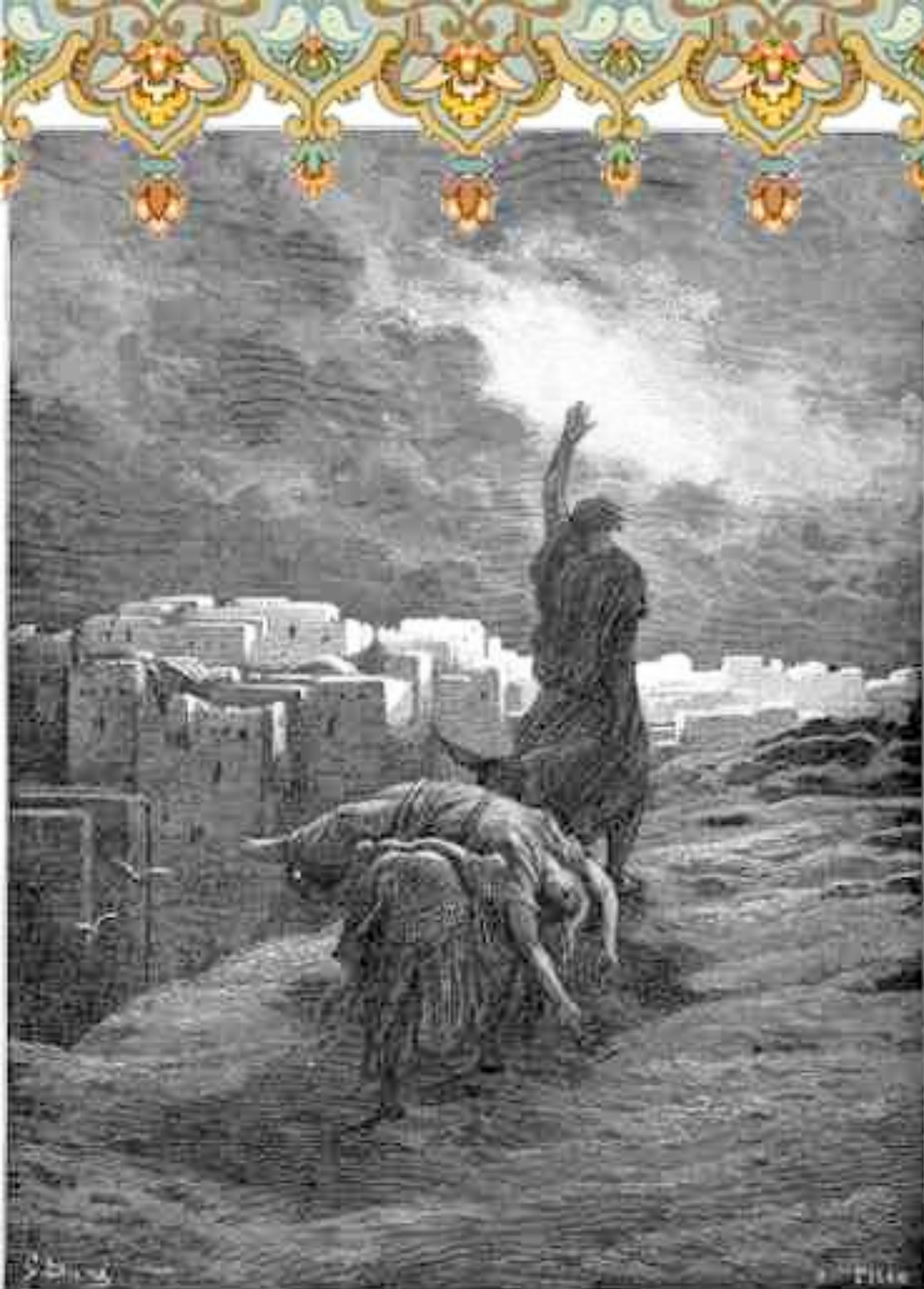
Then the king assumed and said, Give her the living child, and to her own death she is the mother thereof. — II Kings ii. 27. (5-34)

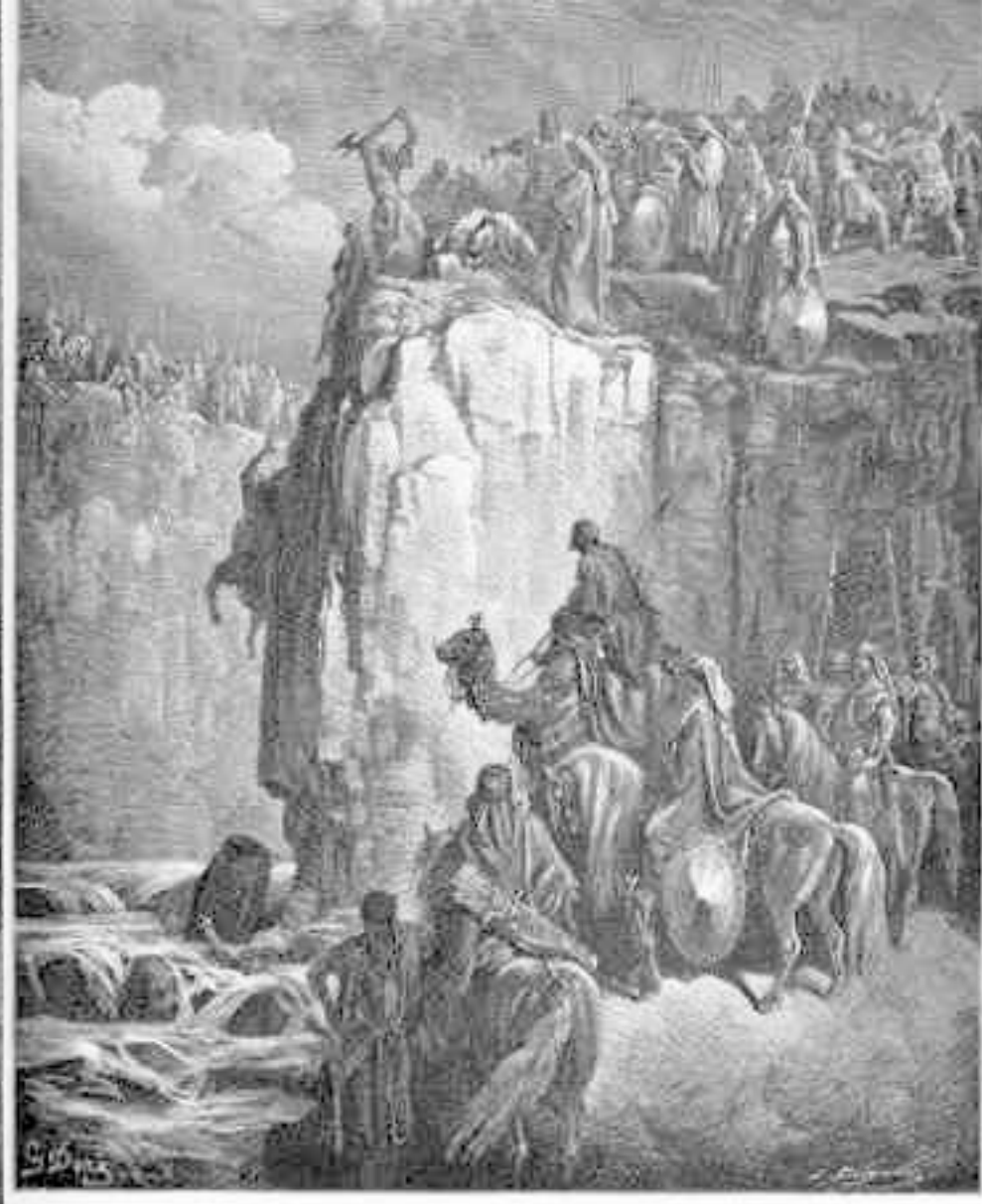
ISAIAH
